
# 175th Church Anniversary

On Sunday November 19, 2023, Second Baptist Church celebrated its historic 175th Church Anniversary. The church was formally established as one of two of the city's oldest "African American churches", which was conceived in 1827 and officially established as Second Baptist Church in 1848.

This anniversary underscores a milestone in African American history and their legacy of service. District historians say the church was a stop on the Underground Railroad and was a venue for historical icons including Booker T. Washington, Frederick Douglass and Sojourner Truth. The church is also the site of the founding of the National Baptist Convention and is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places.

Since 1997, Rev. Dr. James E. Terrell has served as the fourteenth Pastor of Second Baptist Church. He was Assistant to the Pastor of Second Baptist Church from 1991-1997. Rev. Terrell, along with the support and hard work of the church members, has consistently led Second Baptist Church's commitment of service for future generations in downtown Washington, D.C., by seeking new ways to reach out to the community. Second Baptist Church continues as a legacy and symbol of the vibrant African American community.

The Stoddard Family congratulates and honors Rev. Terrell and the Church Family for the many years of dedication and service in the community. Likewise, Rev. Terrell is appreciated for his faithful years of service as a Stoddard Baptist Nursing Home Board Member who currently serves as the Treasurer. May God greatly bless Rev. 
